Bharata Kalarpana Rules and Regulations

Students are expected to attend all scheduled classes. There is no refund or make-ups for unattended classes. A student who repeatedly misses classes or is learning at a different speed can be moved to a junior group.

Parents are expected to drop and pick up students promptly. Carpools are strongly encouraged. There is no parking available at the studio but for drop-offs.

Once students have completed the basic Adavus (steps) and moved onto learning items, we encourage students to perform outside of school-organized events. It is the responsibility of the student to inform the Guru about upcoming performances and arrange for extra practices if necessary.

Dance students must wear the appropriate dance uniform to class and have hair neatly tied back. Pottu/ Bindi must be worn. Students should carry a dance bag with notebook, pencils, extra bindis, and a water bottle to class.

Bharata Kalarpana Dance students must complete a minimum of two years of vocal music training. All students completing an arangetram are strongly encouraged to study vocal music alongside with dance. Students taking both classes will receive a tuition discount.

Tuition for all beginner students is \$100/month each for Dance, Music or Veda Class. Please make checks payable to Sivakami Bhavanandan. Tuition is due by the first class of the month. A \$10 late fee will be assessed for students who have not submitted their fees by the 10th of the month.

Please note that a non-refundable registration fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) is required to be enrolled in a dance class with Bharata Kalarpana. At the end of the first year, this fee will be applied to the purchase of required dance practice uniform. (Kalakshetra dance sari or dance kurtha and pyjama.)
